

# Replacement Instructions

# Quick Change Filters - CQC1, CQC1-KDF

Please ensure you have read the instructions and that no parts are missing prior to installation.

#### Please note

We recommend turning your purifier off while on holiday or away from home for long periods of time.

The approximate life of your filter is one year and will vary depending on several factors, i.e. manufacturers recommendation, amount of water being used through the filter, turbid water supply, amount of sediment in the water etc. If the flow through the filter decreases or water taste deteriorates it may be time to replace the filter.

How do you know when it's time to replace your cartridge? We place your name in our records; this allows us to remember when you received your new cartridge. We will then remind you when it is time to replace it.

### Step one

Turn the water off at the red tap valve.

# Step two

Turn on the cold water tap (faucet) to relieve pressure and remove any excess water from the line.

#### Step three

Turn the cartridge to the left and remove downwards.

#### Step four

Turn off the cold water tap (faucet).

# Step five

Insert the new cartridge & turn to the right to lock – Please note the cartridge can only be fitted one way.

#### Step six

Once secure, turn the water back on at the red tap valve.

#### Step seven

Turn on the cold water tap (faucet) to release the water.

#### Step eight

Check for any leaks

#### Step nine

Water may run cloudy for a while, but will clear.
