

# **Replacement Instructions**

# **Standard Tap**

### Step one

Turn off water to the unit at the piercing valve/ saddle clamp. As per picture to the right:

#### Step two

Turn on the tap to check water is turned off; this also relieves the pressure from the lines.

#### Step three

Undo the Compression Nut; this removes the tubing from the end of the brass shaft.

#### Step four

Undo the Lock nut from the base.

## Step five

You will now be able to lift the tap up and out of the hole on the bench top. NOTE: your model tap may not have the metal plate with the extra small rubber washer.

#### Step six

Remove old washer/s and fit new ones in place.

#### Step seven

Replace tap into hole in bench top and refit the Lock Nut.

#### Step eight

Replace the Compression Nut, reattaching the tubing to the shaft.
